1. ET-22-400007 (UC-18-0974)-USA:

<u>USE PERMIT SECOND EXTENSION OF TIME</u> for the following: 1) a communication tower; and 2) increase the height of a communication tower.

DESIGN REVIEW for a communication tower on a portion of 307.1 acres in an R-U (Rural Open Land) Zone. Generally located 1,235 feet east of US 95, and 2,325 feet south of SR 163 within Laughlin. (For possible action) To the PC 03/15/2022

Doug Rankin, Planning Manager represented InterConnect Towers. Mr. Rankin explained due to the pandemic funds were not available to move forward until recently. There has been no significant changes since the original approval.
