1. Discuss a request to expand the Bunkerville Cemetery (for discussion only)

Stephen Waite is requesting that Clark County purchase additional property in preparation for the proposed expansion. According to Stephen, the cemetery has approximately 13 years before they run out of plots. The two suggested parcels that were discussed are 002-25-610-010 & 002-25-701-003. Brian Haviland suggested the possibility of a land trade. Stephen prefers to acquire the smaller property in order to keep the cemetery from being divided. He also asked about the possibility of receiving a grant or the possibility of charging for plots in the future. Alex explained the current financial state of Clark County and that he's uncertain what the grant process is going to look like moving forward. Alex will update the commissioner on this discussion. He will have to reach out to legal to see if charging for plots is allowable and raised

the idea of a nonprofit deeding the property. The board discussed that when cemeteries have become privately owned, in the past, they don't seem to have a high success rate and wind up in bankruptcy. The need for a written policy on who can and cannot obtain a plot was discussed. Stephen will work on a draft policy and will submit it to the board at a later date.
