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NOTICE OF FINAL ACTION

On the date indicated above, a Notice of Final Action was filed with the Clark County Clerk, Commission Division, pursuant to NRS 278.0235 and NRS 278.3195, which starts the commencement of the twenty-five (25) day limitation period specified therein.

The above referenced application was presented before the Clark County Board of County Commissioners at their regular meeting of April 18, 2018 and was APPROVED subject to the conditions listed below. You will be required to comply with all conditions prior to the issuance of a building permit or a business license, whichever occurs first.

Time limits to commence, complete or review this approval, apply only to this specific application. A property may have several approved applications on it with each having its own expiration date. It is the applicant's responsibility to keep the application current.

CONDITIONS:

Current Planning

- Satisfy utility companies' requirements.
- Applicant is advised that a substantial change in circumstances or regulations may warrant denial or added conditions to an extension of time; the extension of time may be denied if the project has not commenced or there has been no substantial work towards completion within the time specified; and that the recording of the order of vacation in the Office of the County Recorder must be completed within 2 years of the approval date or the application will expire.

Public Works - Development Review

- Right-of-way dedication to include 30 feet for Dewey Drive and associated spandrel;
- Vacation to be recordable prior to building permit issuance or applicable map submittal;
- Revise legal description, if necessary, prior to recording.

Clark County Water Reclamation District (CCWRD)

• Applicant is advised that CCWRD has existing or proposed assets within the area proposed to be vacated per VS-18-0135; that CCWRD has no objection to the request for vacation as presented; however, CCWRD requests all existing rights granted to us within the easements/right-of-way are reserved; that it is understood that this vacation shall not reduce our rights to operate and maintain our facilities; and that CCWRD also requests that drivable access be able to handle H-20 loading and is maintained by fee owner.
