NOTIFICATION OF PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO CLARK COUNTY CODE, TITLE 22, CHAPTER 22.02 BY MODIFYING THE BUILDING ADMINISTRATIVE CODE OF CLARK COUNTY; AND PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO.

Dear Stakeholders and Community Partners:

Pursuant to NRS 237.080, you are hereby notified of a proposed amendment to Clark County Code, Title 22, Chapter 22.02 of the Building Administrative Code of Clark County (Building Administrative Code) that seeks to amend the existing Building Administrative Code to adopt the 2018 building codes, modifying certain provision of this code along with other matters properly related hereto.
