ALL MAIL BALLOT ELECTION:

All "active" voters who registered in-person or by mail on or before October 11, 2022, or online on the Secretary of State's website on or before October 25, 2022, will be sent a mail ballot. However, those who submitted a "Mail Ballot Preference Form" by September 9, 2022, to opt-out of receiving a mail ballot will not be sent one. Additionally, voters who registered on or after October 19, 2022, will not be sent a sample ballot for the current election.

MAIL BALLOT DROP-OFF LOCATIONS: 172

NOTE: <u>All early voting sites</u> and <u>Election Day Vote Centers</u> will be mail ballot drop-off locations during their scheduled dates and hours of operation. <u>City Clerks' offices and the Clark County Election</u> <u>Department</u> will also be available for mail ballot drop off during varying dates and times.

EARLY VOTING POLLING PLACES: 88

Long-Term Sites (open at the same location for all 14 days early voting): **17** Short-Term Neighborhood Sites (open only on specific dates): **71** NOTE: Instead of voting by mail, you may vote at any <u>early voting site</u> you choose no matter where you live or what your precinct is in Clark County. If you have your mail ballot with you, you must surrender it at the voting site. If you do not have your mail ballot with you, you must sign an affirmation that you are not voting twice in the same election. Additionally, <u>same-day registration and updates</u> of existing registration are available at all Election Day Vote Centers.

ELECTION DAY VOTE CENTERS: 128

NOTE: Instead of voting by mail, you may vote at any <u>Vote Center</u> you choose from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. on Election Day, no matter where you live or what your precinct is in Clark County. If you have your mail ballot with you, you must surrender it at the voting site. If you do not have your mail ballot with you, you must sign an affirmation that you are not voting twice in the same election. Additionally, <u>same-day</u> registration and updates of existing registration are available at all Election Day Vote Centers.
