ALL MAIL BALLOT ELECTION:

All "<u>active</u>" voters registered in Ward I of the City of Henderson on or before March 27, 2023, will automatically be sent a mail ballot. However, those who submitted a "<u>Mail</u> <u>Ballot Preference Form</u>" on or before February 2, 2023, to opt-out of receiving a mail ballot will not be sent one.

MAIL BALLOT DROP-OFF LOCATIONS: 2

If you choose to vote by mail ballot, you may return your voted ballot to the Election Department using the U.S. Postal Service or by putting it into a mail ballot drop box. The <u>early voting site and Election Day Vote Center</u> at Henderson City Hall will be a mail ballot drop-off location during scheduled dates and hours of operation. The <u>Clark County</u> <u>Election Department</u> will also be available for mail ballot drop off.

EARLY VOTING POLLING PLACE: 1

Instead of voting by mail, you may vote at the <u>early voting site</u> at Henderson City Hall. Only voters registered in Ward I of the City of Henderson may vote in this election. If you have your mail ballot with you, you must surrender it at the voting site. If you do not have it with you, you must sign an affirmation stating that you are not voting twice in the same election. Additionally, <u>same-day registration and updates</u> of existing registration are available at the early voting site.

ELECTION DAY VOTE CENTER: 1

Instead of voting by mail, you may vote at the <u>Vote Center</u> at Henderson City Hall from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. on Election Day. Only voters registered in Ward I of the City of Henderson may vote in this election. If you have your mail ballot with you, you must surrender it at the voting site. If you do not have it with you, you must sign an affirmation stating that you are not voting twice in the same election. Additionally, <u>same-day registration and updates</u> of existing registrations are available at the Election Day Vote Center.
