## Mail Ballot Drop-Off Deadline 7:00 p.m. on Election Day

Per NRS 293.269921

**Drop Box Deadline:** By <u>7:00 p.m. on Election Day</u>, you may deposit your voted mail ballot in an official drop box, including if you were waiting in line at a drop box by 7:00 p.m. The ONLY exception is if a court order extends voting hours by requiring the polls to stay open after 7:00 p.m. on Election Day.

**If You Are Late:** Drop off your ballot by <u>8:59 P.M. on Election Day at the</u> <u>U.S. Post Office</u> below to ensure your ballot has an Election Day postmark.



## **Remember:**

- **ENVELOPE:** Seal your voted mail ballot inside <u>your</u> postage-paid return envelope with <u>your</u> pre-printed name and address. You MUST use that envelope to return your voted mail ballot. If you do not have <u>your</u> envelope, voting sites can provide a replacement during voting hours.
- **SIGNATURE:** Sign the outside of <u>your</u> return envelope before depositing it.
- **DO NOT:** Do not sign the ballot itself. Do not put your voted mail ballot in another voter's return envelope.
