Ballot is removed from envelope here. EXTRACTION & EXTRACTION & EXTRA	<ul> <li>The mail ballot envelopes are opened, and the mail ballot and secrecy sleeve are removed and separated.</li> <li>Ballots are flattened and visually inspected to ensure the mail ballot voting instructions were followed and the ballot can be read by our tabulation scanners.</li> </ul>
Ballot is removed for BALLOT BALLOT BALLOT	<ul> <li>Bipartisan teams create a new physical ballot when a ballot is damaged or marked in a way that may prevent a vote from being read by a scanner.</li> <li>BIPARTISAN TEAM</li> </ul>
IMPRINTING	<ul> <li>Ballots are imprinted with a unique number used to conduct a post-election tabulation audit called a risk-limiting audit (RLA).</li> </ul>
TABULATION	<ul> <li>Ballots are run through high-speed scanners that capture the selections made by the voters.</li> <li>Any ballots that cannot be read by the scanner are logged and sent back to the Central Counting Board for duplication.</li> </ul>
ADJUDICATION	<ul> <li>Ballots that require adjudication due to an apparent overvote or an ambiguous mark on a ballot go to bipartisan teams of adjudicators to be resolved.</li> <li>BIPARTISAN TEAM</li> </ul>
BALLOT STORAGE	<ul> <li>After being scanned, ballots are put into boxes that are sealed and brought to a secure storage area.</li> <li>The sealed ballot boxes are retained for 22 months as required by law.</li> </ul>
