### **2021 BOULDER CITY GENERAL ELECTION IMPORTANT DATES**

The important dates for the 2021 Boulder City General Election are as follows:	
May 18, 2021	Last day to register to vote by mail for the General Election without appearing in person at the Clerk's Office
May 19 - June 1, 2021	Standard online only registration only by 6/1/2021 at 11:59 p.m.
June 1, 2021	Last day for City Clerk to receive requests for absentee ballots for the General Election
June 2 - June 10, 2021	Same day registration online
June 3, 2021	Early voting for the General Election begins
June 3 - June 11, and June 15, 2021	Same day registration in-person updates
June 10, 2021	Last day to register to vote by computer for the General Election
June 11, 2021	Early voting for the General Election ends
June 15, 2021	GENERAL ELECTION DAY

### **Boulder City - Same Day Registration Period\***

Voters that register during this period will be required to present an unexpired Nevada Driver's License or Identification Card issued by the DMV. If you are already registered and you update your record during this period, you do not have to present ID. See our website for more information regarding Same Day Registration requirements at <u>www.clarkcountynv.gov/vote</u>. Same Day Registration will be available at all Election Day Vote Centers or early voting sites. For online registration/updates go to <u>www.RegistertoVoteNV.gov</u>.

Digitally preview your mail and manage your packages scheduled to arrive soon! Informed Delivery allows you to view greyscale images of the exterior, address side of letter-sized mailpieces and track packages in one convenient location. You can check the delivery of your mail ballot with this easy to use service.
