PRESIDENTIAL PREFERENCE PRIMARY (PPP)

Overview: On February 6, 2024, Nevada will have its first ever Presidential Preference Primary (PPP). Early Voting will be seven days from January 27 to February 2, 2024. Per NRS 298.600-720, added in 2021, the Clark County Election Department will conduct the PPP like all elections in Clark County, Nevada, and it will be an all-mail ballot election. In-person voting options will still be available during Early Voting and on Election Day.

Who May Vote: All active Clark County voters regardless of party affiliation will receive a sample ballot. However, only active voters registered as Democratic or Republican will receive a mail ballot or may vote in-person (instead of by mail) at any Early Voting site or Election Day vote center.

How to Update Your Existing Registration or Register to Vote: If you wish to update your party affiliation or address, you may do so at www.RegisterToVoteNV.gov or in person when you check in to vote. New voters who provide acceptable identification may also register at www.RegisterToVoteNV.gov or in person when they check in to vote. Acceptable identification is a current and valid Nevada Driver's License, Nevada State Identification Card, Nevada Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) Interim Document, or Tribal Identification Card per NRS 232.006 (cannot be used for online registration). For other options for updating an existing registration or registering to vote, contact us.

Non-Major Party Presidential Candidates: Candidates whose party is anything other than Democratic or Republican cannot participate in the PPP. Qualified non-major party candidates will go directly to the General Election ballot.

PPP Election Day: Tuesday, February 6, 2024

PPP Early Voting: Saturday, January 27, to Friday, February 2, 2024 (seven days)

Other Elections in 2024:

- Primary Election: Election Day is Tuesday, June 11, and Early Voting is Saturday, May 25, to Friday, June 7
- General Election: Election Day is Tuesday, November 5, and Early Voting is Saturday, October 19, to Friday, November 1

NOTICES

Assistance is Available at the Voting Site: Ask any election worker for assistance if you need help reading the ballot or operating the voting machine. Reasonable accommodations will be made to help any voter requesting assistance at a voting site. (This notice is required by NRS 293.565.)

For Voters with Special Needs: Every voting site has a voting machine that can display the ballot in extra large font, print the voter verifiable paper trail tape in large font, provide audio voting, and support "sip and puff" technology.

ADA EASE: Nevada residents with a disability can mark their ballot electronically by going to <u>www.NVEASE.gov</u>. The Nevada's Effective Absentee System for Elections (EASE) is an online application that seamlessly integrates voter registration, electronic ballot delivery, and marking. EASE allows further independence and enables registered voters with a disability to register, request, mark, and return their ballots from the comfort of their own homes. EASE is available for elections 45 days before Election Day at <u>www.NVEASE.gov</u>. If you have any questions regarding this voting method, please contact the Secretary of State of Nevada, Elections Office, at (775) 684-5705.

You May Be Asked for Identification at the Voting Site: If the data you provided on your voter registration application did not match the data on file at the Department of Motor Vehicles or the Social Security Administration, as applicable, and you did not respond to the letter notifying you of the discrepancy, you will be required to provide identification when you appear to vote. If you do not provide identification, you will only be allowed to vote provisionally. The words "ID Required" on the address label of this sample ballot indicate you will be required to provide identification at the time you vote.

Voter Verifiable Paper Trail: Each voting machine in Clark County has a printer attached to the touch screen machine that will print a paper copy of your selections once you indicate you have made all your choices. You can then review the selections to ensure you have not made a mistake before casting your ballot. If you note a mistake, you can correct the error and review another printout before casting your ballot. Once you cast your ballot, the paper printout, which is protected by a plastic cover, will scroll out of view and the machine will be ready for the next voter.

"None of These Candidates:" In all statewide contests, you have the option to select "None of These Candidates." You may only select "None of These Candidates" if you do not vote for any candidate for the office. (This notice is required by NRS 293.269(3).)

ELECTRONIC SAMPLE BALLOTS

UPDATING YOUR REGISTRATION

You can now update your voter registration information online if you have a Nevada driver's license or Nevada DMV-issued Identification (ID). Simply go to <u>www.RegisterToVoteNV.gov</u> and update your address if you no longer reside at the address at which you registered or wish to change your political party. Eligible citizens who are not registered may also register online if they have a Nevada driver's license or Nevada DMV-issued ID.

LANGUAGE INFORMATION

In October 2021, Clark County was notified by the Civil Rights Division of the U.S. Department of Justice that in accordance with Section 203 of the Voting Rights Act, all future elections in Clark County must continue to be conducted in English, Filipino, and Spanish. <u>WARNING</u> <u>Voting More than Once in the</u> <u>Same Election Is a Crime</u>

A person who is entitled to vote shall not vote or attempt to vote more than once at the same election. Any person who votes or attempts to vote twice at the same election is guilty of a category D felony and shall be punished as provided in NRS 193.130. (Publication of this warning is required by NRS 293.780)

Attention Voters

Important Information... Please Read Carefully

Two ballots are printed in your sample ballot. If you are registered as Democratic, refer to the ballot printed on a blue background. If you are registered as Republican, refer to the ballot printed on a yellow background. Only voters registered as Democratic or Republican may vote in the Presidential Preference Primary, even though all active Clark County voters will receive a sample ballot, regardless of party. See the page on the Presidential Preference Primary for more details.

If You Are Registered as Democratic:

Your ballot is printed on page 20 on a blue background.

If You Are Registered as Republican:

Your ballot is printed on page 21 on a yellow background.

Presidential Preference Primary Election Early Voting Sites / Mail Ballot Drop-Off Locations January 27 (Saturday) to February 2 (Friday), 2024

All early voting sites are also mail ballot drop-off locations during the listed dates and times.

Unforeseen events or circumstances may cause changes to early voting locations or hours of operation. For updates, see our website at www.ClarkCountyNV.gov/vote or call (702) 455-VOTE (8683).

Any registered voter in Clark County may vote in-person before Election Day at any early voting site instead of voting by mail.

You may also drop off your voted mail ballot in-person at any early voting site <u>during the</u> <u>specific dates and times in this schedule</u>. See the listings for "Election Day Vote Centers..." and "Additional Mail Ballot Drop-Off Locations" for other drop-off options. You must still sign the outside of the postage-paid return envelope provided specifically for you, showing your name and address, and seal your voted ballot inside of this envelope before you deposit it in the drop box. *Do not put your ballot in another voter's return envelope*.

If you decide to vote in-person instead of by mail, you will need to do one of the following:

- If you have your mail ballot, surrender it in the packet sent to you to an election official at the voting site.
- If you do <u>not</u> have your mail ballot but had received it in the mail, you will sign an affirmation at the voting site swearing that you have not already voted in the current election and that you understand no one may attempt to vote or actually vote more than once in the same election.

If you lose or spoil <u>your</u> mail ballot return envelope with your preprinted name and address (included in your mail ballot packet), IMMEDIATELY call us at (702) 455-VOTE (8683) for replacement envelope information.

Mail Ballot Postmark, Receiving, and Drop-Off Deadlines:

- Voted mail ballots must be mailed or dropped off in the Election Department's postage-paid return envelope which you must also sign.
- Mailed ballots must be:
 - Postmarked on or before Tuesday, February 6, 2024; and
 - Received by the Election Department no later Saturday, February 10, 2024, at 5 p.m., the fourth day following Election Day.
 - Ballots may also be dropped off at ANY Early Voting site during the specified voting dates and hours or at ANY Election Day Vote Center from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.

Sign the Outside of the Return Envelope: You must sign the outside of <u>your</u> Election Department return envelope in the space provided. If you do not sign, then your mail ballot may not be counted. **IMPORTANT:** Your signature will be checked against what is in the voter registration records.

Only Place Your Own Ballot in <u>Your</u> **Own Return Envelope:** Do not put anyone else's ballot in <u>your</u> return envelope with your pre-printed name on it. If more ballots than your own are inside the envelope when it is returned, then none of the ballots will be counted.

Clearly Mark Your Ballot Per the Instructions: Read and follow the voting instructions in your mail ballot packet to clearly mark your choices and ensure your ballot is counted.

- Avoid stray marks and tearing the ballot.
- Do not put the "I Voted" sticker on your ballot.
- Do not sign the ballot itself.

Return Your Voted Ballot as Soon as Possible: Do not wait until the last minute to return your voted mail ballot. Mail it as soon as possible or deposit it at one of the Election Department's drop-off locations. A drop-off location listing is included in your sample ballot, in your mail ballot packet, and at www.ClarkCountyNV.gov/vote.

Secrecy Sleeve: A secrecy sleeve is included in your packet so that you may place your voted mail ballot inside of it before putting it inside your return envelope. However, the secrecy sleeve is not required. Your voted mail ballot will not be rejected simply because you did not include the secrecy sleeve.

The Clark County Election Department needs Poll Workers for 2024. With three elections during the calendar year, the Election Department prefers prospective employees who can work all three elections during the Early Voting periods and on Election Days. The Department especially needs workers who are fluent in Spanish, Filipino, or Mandarin Chinese.

- When: Presidential Preference Primary (PPP) Early Voting is from January 27 to February 2, 2024, and Election Day is Tuesday, February 6, 2024.
 - <u>Primary Election</u> Early Voting is from May 25 to June 7, 2024, and Election Day is Tuesday, June 11, 2024.
 - <u>General Election</u> Early Voting from October 19 to November 1, 2024, and Election Day is Tuesday, November 5, 2024.

Pay:

- Election Day poll workers receive a flat rate of \$200 for the day.
- Early voting poll workers are paid \$17 per hour.
- Workers who are required to attend training will receive \$50 for the class.

<u>Requirements</u>: All poll workers must meet <u>all</u> of the requirements below:

- Be a registered voter in Clark County, NV, or, be enrolled in High School and at least 16 years of age.
- Not be a candidate or relative of a candidate for nomination or election in 2024.
- Not be a poll watcher or observer during any election you work.
- Successfully complete the Election Department's training if required.
