This O₃ SIP Revision will update the approved motor vehicle emissions budgets (MVEBs) for volatile organic compounds and nitrogen oxides contained in the *Ozone Redesignation Request and Maintenance Plan* for the 1997 8-hour ozone standard using the most recent U.S. Environmental Protection Agency-approved motor vehicle emissions model (MOVES2014a) and the most current planning variables (e.g., vehicle miles traveled projections and population forecasts). Once approved, the MVEBs in the O₃ SIP Revision will become the projected budgets that the Regional Transportation Commission of Southern Nevada will use for determining transportation conformity in the future under Section 176(c) of the Clean Air Act.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that a 30-day public comment period will begin on August 17, 2018, and end at 4:00 PM on September 17, 2018. The public may review and provide written comments on the proposed O₃ SIP Revision during this period. The Board of County Commissioners will consider the O₃ SIP Revision, along with all written and any oral public comments, at a public hearing at 10:00 AM on October 16, 2018, in the Commission Chambers, Clark County Government Center, 500 S. Grand Central Parkway, Las Vegas, NV.

BACKGROUND:

The Board of County Commissioners (Board) adopted the Clark County *Ozone Redesignation Request and Maintenance Plan* (2011 Maintenance Plan) for the 1997 8-hour ozone National Ambient Air Quality Standard (NAAQS) in March 2011. On January 8, 2013, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) found Clark County had attained the standard, issuing final approval of the 2011 Maintenance Plan and redesignating the nonattainment area to attainment for the 1997 8-hour ozone NAAQS, effective February 7, 2013.

The attached revision will update the approved motor vehicle emissions budgets (MVEBs) for volatile organic compounds and nitrogen oxides in the 2011 Maintenance Plan using the most recent EPA-approved motor vehicle emissions model (MOVES2014a) and the most current planning variables (e.g., vehicle miles traveled projections and population forecasts). The Regional Transportation Commission of Southern Nevada (RTC) is responsible for determining the conformity of regional transportation plans, programs, and projects to approved state implementation plan budgets. Once approved, the MVEBs in this revision will become the projected budgets the RTC uses to determine future transportation conformity under Section 176(c) of the Clean Air Act. Appendix B documents the public review process. Information not yet available will be added after the public hearing and upon Board approval of this revision.

The proposed revision was made available for public review and comment from August 17, 2018 through September 17, 2018 on the Department of Air Quality (DAQ) website and at the DAQ office at 4701 West Russell Road. No comments were received.
