5	PROCEDURES IN SUMMARY EVICTION	
6	ACTIONS	
7	WHEREAS, Governor's Emergency	Directive 036, as amended by Governor's
8	Emergency Directive 043, imposed a stay on certain qualifying unlawful detainer and summary	
9	eviction actions;	
10	, WHEREAS, temporary changes to local procedures are necessary to ensure ongoing	
11	compliance with the Governor's Emergency Directives; therefore,	
12	IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the following temporary changes shall be implemented	
13	immediately:	
14	1. Summary eviction orders previously issued by the Court that are stayed pursuant to	
15	Emergency Directive 036 will expire and must be re-issued by the Court prior to re-	
16	posting the order.	
17	a. Landlords will have thirty (30) days after the termination of Emergency Directive 036	
18	to file a motion with the Court requesting the re-issuance of an eviction order with an	
19	affidavit or declaration under the penalty of perjury that states:	
20	i. The same tenant is still occupying the premises; and	
21	ii. That the Landlord has not accepted any funds from any source which would	
22	impact the Landlord's right to proceed with a lockout.	
23	2. Landlords must file a motion to rescind any eviction order where a subsequent	

24	agreement, mediation, curative action, payment of defaulted rent, or acceptance of	
25	assistance funds has fully resolved the issues between the parties and resulted in a	
26	continuation of the tenancy.	
27	3. Rule 34(e) of the Local Rules of Practice for the Justice Court of Henderson Township is	
28	suspended for all Covered Evictions, as defined by Section 3 of Emergency Directive	
29	036, until the Directive is terminated.	
30	a. Landlords will have thirty (30) days after termination of Emergency Directive 036, as	
31	amended by Emergency Directive 043, to file an affidavit of complaint for summary	
32	eviction for these stayed Covered Evictions.	
33	b. If no complaint is filed within thirty (30) days, the case will be administratively closed.	
34	IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this administrative order shall continue until May 31, 2021,	
35	or until modified or rescinded by a subsequent order, whichever occurs earlier.
