NOTICE OF AVAILABILTY OF REMOTE WITNESS TESTIMONY BY TELECONFERENCE OR VIDEOCONFERENCE

Pursuant to Part IX of the Nevada Supreme Court Rules, Moapa Valley Justice Court is providing notice that it has the capability of accepting remove witness testimony via either a teleconference or videoconference. That is, witnesses, attorney, and/or parties may appear either over the telephone or through a videoconference that will be heard or seen in the courtroom. The appearance will be recorded over the Court's electronic reporting system. The system will allow two-way communication so that any testimony or appearance is fully interactive.

The rules concerning whether a party, attorney, and/or witness can appear remotely in either civil or criminal matters are set forth in Part IX of the Nevada Supreme Court Rules. The rules and the procedures for applying for such appearances differ depending on whether the appearance is by teleconference or videoconference and whether it is a civil or criminal matter.

The court can only provide limited technical support for remote appearances, and any party or witness seeking to use the system is encouraged to test the connectivity of their system with the Court's system prior to the hearing date.
