6. Continued discussion on identifying a possible sculpture or mural project that highlights the diversity of the Clark County community, including identifying possible locations and general scope (*not an action item*).

7. Approve the purchase of the sculpture "Black Tailed Jack Rabbit", 4' x 9.5' x 4' cast concrete by David Phelps of Phelps Sculpture Studio and construction for the Wetlands Children's Play Area for \$37,000 from the Wetlands Monument Sign & Art leaving the fund with \$213,000 left over for other projects (*for possible action*).

- The Committee did not approve purchase due to the sculpture being a reproduction of existing pieces, therefore it is not considered artwork in accordance to the Clark County, Nevada County Arts Plan of 2013.
 - Arts Plan 2013, PG 4: For the purposes of this plan, the term "works of art" does not mean: (A) commercially mass-produced objects of standard designs, except where these elements are integral parts of an original artwork; (B) reproductions, by mechanical or other means, of original works of art, except in cases of film, video, photography, printmaking or other media arts;
 - Pg 11: In special circumstances the County may accept unsolicited proposals, particularly donations, but those proposals will be evaluated primarily on the basis of artistic merit; in the case of proposed works, on the reputation of the artist, or with completed works, the artist's reputation and the quality of the work itself.
