Please consider my request to evaluate the art installation at Eastern and I-215. The bold head sculptures look harsh in the asphalt median. Please consider pushing for a landscaped median to bring this art into harmony with the neighborhood. I have taken the liberty to create a rendering for a thoughtful landscape plan. This simple plan would include Pine Muhly grasses (muhlembergia dubia) and whales tongue agave. The sculptures would have two soft up lights and ground mulched with 'Mojave Gold' rock mulch. Here is my amateur rendering of an ideal plan:
