

**Clark County Public Art Committee Meeting  
September 26, 2017 at 3:30 pm

I. MEETING OPENING / Introduction of new CCPA Supervisor: Eric Strain opened the meeting. In attendance: committee members – Rebecca Holden, Vicki Richardson, Harold Bradford, Keith Conley and Robert Fielden. Excused: Louisa McDonald Staff: Mickey Sprott, Julie Navis, Patty Dominguez, Ed Fuentes and Diane Bush. Public: Denise Duarte and Fred Wasser (KNPR Radio).

II. MINUTES - **Robert moved to approve June 27, 2017 minutes, Keith seconded. The motion passed unanimously.**

III. APPROVAL OF AGENDA – **Robert moved to approve agenda, Rebecca seconded. The motion passed unanimously.**

IV. West Flamingo Senior Program Yarn-Bombing & Mosaics Projects Proposal, Diane Bush

Diane Bush suggested three proposals to the committee. One is a mosaic ceramic display on an outdoor wall and for the seniors of the center to help. Two is to paint on the long extensive wall between the center and a Chinese, Buddhist temple a dark green and have participants make it look like bamboo. Robert asked about the bamboo theme and suggested maybe planting bamboo. Harold said he did a project similar where they cut PVC pipe to simulate bamboo. Three is to yarn-bomb a bridge. Mickey said Wetlands Park has some bridges and they're interested in bringing some public art to their park.

No action was taken on this item.

V. Annual Report to County Commission, Mickey

Mickey said we're going to the commission on October 17, 2017 to submit the County Arts plan to set the budget for fiscal year 2018.

VI. What is the next step for the Urban Art Project? Maryland Pkwy Art Overlay Project, Mickey

Mickey said she was approached by Strategic Planning for a recommendation. She said she wants to create a small committee for approval and this also has a quick turn-around. Eric asked when we need to do the plan. He also said he would like to see the final version before diving into it. Robert thinks that if we are going to do an overlay, it should come through the committee. Robert would like to have this as an action item on the next agenda after Patty sends the final report to the committee.

Eric asked if we could call an emergency meeting next Tuesday, October 3 before the plan is due, so the committee can discuss coming up with a big project for Maryland Pkwy. The committee agreed.

Patty said that Commissioner Weekly and North Las Vegas City Councilmen were very excited about partnering. Patty also reached out to a couple of people at CSN. If we can get the buy in from all parties, we can do a "Call for Artists" in November and have the applications by Christmas time and then start the project in January.

VIII. Moapa Valley Community Center Mural & Ratpack Crossroads Project Photos, Patty

Moapa Valley Mural- Patty said Gig Dipeo has a third of the mural done. Gig, Patty and Channel 4 have been documenting the process. There was a written amendment to his contract to get more money and more time. He was granted permission from the County. His mural size is now 40 feet by 12 feet and the cost went from \$27,000 to \$30,000.

Rat Pack- Patty said Wayne has been working with Public Works. He wanted solar lights to light the project, wasn't granted permission to do it. He's in the process of coming up with a different way to light it.

Mickey said this project is actually at Las Vegas Blvd. and Nellis. An overhead of the area was shown to the committee. The median was also shown. This was moved to the emergency meeting on Tuesday to take action and vote on.
