

NOTICE OF ROAD CONSTRUCTION LAS VEGAS BLVD - RUSSELL RD TO TROPICANA AVE (PHASE C&D)

Clark County Department of Public Works (CCPW) is reaching out to inform you of upcoming construction activity on the Las Vegas Boulevard between Russell Road to Tropicana Avenue (Phase C&D) Project.

On Monday, June 16 construction will begin for the Las Vegas Blvd Project, Phase C & D. This 2-year-long project involves the installation of a replacement waterline for the Las Vegas Valley Water District along Las Vegas Boulevard between Russell Road and Tropicana Avenue. The \$60 million project includes roadway resurfacing, traffic signal modifications, street lighting and smart poles, power upgrades, and bollard installation for safety enhancements for pedestrians.

Please drive safely in the work zone and be advised of the following:

- Traffic lanes within the project area will be restricted or closed at various times and are subject to change throughout the duration of the project.
- Message boards will be placed in advance of traffic control changes.
- Local traffic is encouraged to use alternate routes whenever possible.

Property owners or tenants who may be affected directly by restricted access will be notified by the contractor.
