CLARK COUNTY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG)

5th SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT TO THE 2020-2024 CONSOLIDATED PLAN AND THE 2024 HUD ANNUAL ACTION PLAN

Clark County proposes to reallocate from unobligated/de-obligated CDBG program and administrative funds the sum of \$7,800,000 to the SafeNest One Safe Place project which is an approved project in the FY2020-2024 Capital Improvement Plan.

The funding will be used by SafeNest to acquire land and building for programs delivering holistic services to survivors of domestic and sexual abuse and those in immediate danger or fleeing harmful situations. The services will include access to advocacy via hotline and in-person, emergency shelter, housing resources, and support with long-term solutions such as temporary and extended protection orders, counselling, food pantry, workforce development, law enforcement, and relocation assistance.

Consistent with the Citizens' Participation Plan, the proposal is now being submitted for public comments. Comments should be sent in writing to <u>CRMInfo@ClarkCountyNV.Gov</u> or mailed to 1600 Pinto Lane, Las Vegas, NV 89106 and will be accepted until 5:30PM on January 22, 2025.

Once approved, the 2020-2024 Consolidated Plan and 2024 Annual Action Plan will be amended to reflect this allocation and submitted to HUD.

PUBLIC COMMENT

The 5th Substantial Amendment to the 2020-2024 Consolidated Plan and the 2024 HUD Annual Action Plan was posted for a 15-day public comment period in the Las Vegas Review Journal and El Mundo on January 7, 2025.
