# 9. Project Outcomes Data measured under the performance standards developed in consultation with the CoC(s)

Of the beneficiaries assisted and entering shelter, 29% went on to permanent housing, 12% to transitional housing, 1% to an institution, 6% to emergency shelter, 3% to other and 51% to unknown.

Of the beneficiaries assisted with homeless prevention and rapid re-housing, 96% remained or became permanently housed, 2% went to transitional housing, and 3% to emergency shelter.
